School Government

This is a two hour overview of school government structures, as defined by your state constitution and laws, that affect your educational stakeholder responsibilities.

C100 – Introduction to Your State’s Constitution

You will learn your State’s connection to the U.S. Constitution, the creation of Your State’s Constitution, and its Pre-Amble and Article 1.

C200 – Legislative Branch

Learn the structure and operation of your State’s Legislative Branch.

C300 – Executive Branch

Learn the structure and operation of your State’s Executive Branch.

C400 – Judicial Branch

Learn the structure and operation of your State’s Judicial Branch.

C500 – Regional and Local Governments

You will learn the structure and operation of your State’s Regional, County, City/Town, and School governments

FOUNDATIONAL CIVICS

Class is 2 hours; Tuition \$25/person; Workbook included
No Prerequisites

Introduction to Government Structures

You will learn basic Government Structures, understand concepts of Power, System, and Control, and identify jurisdictional boundaries and controls.

POLITICAL LEADERSHIP TRAINING SERIES

Tuition is \$50/person/block; Workbooks are included; \$40/17 & under/class; Prerequisites

BLOCK I: Introduction to Systematic Politics

(No prerequisites; 2-3 hours)

You will distinguish Partisan from Systematic Politics, learn the origins of Systematic Politics, and identify the Systematic Politics of Layer and Marble Cake Federalism.

BLOCK 2: Competitive Systematic Politics – Inside Gaming (Prerequisites: Intro to Systematic Politics & Training Exercises; 3-4 hrs)

You will analyze the Systematic Politics of Marble Cake Federalism, study Partisan Political cycles, its influence on the Governing’s decision-making & behavior, and develop Systematic Political strategies to compete with Marble Cake Federalism.

BLOCK 3: Competitive Systematic Politics – Outside Gaming (Prerequisites: Competitive Systematic Politics - Inside Gaming & Training Exercises; 3-4 hrs)

You will analyze the Systematic Politics of Marble Cake Federalism, study Partisan Political cycles, its influence on the Governed’s decision-making & behavior, and develop Systematic Political strategies to compete with Marble Cake Federalism.

GRADUATION – Complete each BLOCK and associated Training Exercises for BLOCKS #1-3.

MESSAGING TRAINING

Class is 2-3 hours; Tuition is \$50/person; Prerequisites: Block #2 & completed Training Exercises

Introduction to Messaging

You will define Messaging, learn verbal and non-verbal cues, understand the Influence Life Cycle, how to build credibility, how to craft and deliver a message, and interpreting feedback through an in-class exercise.

School Government

(2 hours/Live In-Person or Live Online)

City Government

(2 hours/Live In-Person or Live Online)

Tuition: \$25 per student

This is a two hour overview of *city government* structures, as defined by your state constitution and laws, that affect your local stakeholder responsibilities.

County Government

(2 hours/Live In-Person or Live Online)

Tuition: \$25 per student

This is a two hour overview of *county government* structures, as defined by your state constitution and laws, that affect your *political participation and influence* at every level of government.

Regional Government

(2 hours/Live In-Person or Live Online)

Tuition: \$25 per student

This is a two hour overview of *regional government* structures, as defined by your state constitution and laws, that affect your *regional* stakeholder responsibilities.

State Constitution Classes (Online/Live)

The state constitution study program exposes the student to 1) the state's organization of control between elected, appointed, and employed governing; 2) distribution of power between the departments of state government; and 3) the legal subdivisions within the state.

Time: 2+ hours per class

Tuition: \$25 per student per class

Optional state-specific workbook is an additional fee.
